Clarinet

-pull-through cleaning swab

-polishing cloth

-cork grease

-mouthpiece brush

-optional accessories: reed holder, thumb cushion

WHAT DO I NEED TO TAKE CARE OF MY INSTRUMENT?



Flute

- metal or plastic cleaning rod (included with your instrument)**
- reusable “J” cloth (clean inside)**
- silver polishing cloth (clean outside only)**
- optional accessories: finger rest, pad cleaning paper, key cleaning brush**

Trumpet

- valve oil**
- tuning slide grease (not cream)**
- cleaning snake**
- valve brush**
- mouthpiece brush**
- brass polishing cloth**

WHAT DO I NEED TO TAKE CARE OF MY INSTRUMENT?



Trombone

- slide cream (not oil – big slide)**
- tuning slide grease (small slide)**
- cleaning snake**
- valve brush**
- mouthpiece brush**
- brass polishing cloth**
- optional: slide spray bottle**

Euphonium

- valve oil**
- tuning slide grease (not cream)**
- cleaning snake**
- valve brush**
- mouthpiece brush**
- brass polishing cloth**

WHAT DO I NEED TO TAKE CARE OF MY INSTRUMENT?



Tuba

- valve oil
- tuning slide grease (not cream)
- valve brush
- mouthpiece brush
- brass polishing cloth
- *cleaning snake (not pictured)

WHAT DO I NEED TO TAKE CARE OF MY INSTRUMENT?



Alto and Tenor Saxophone

- pull-through cleaning swab**
- neck cleaner**
- cork grease**
- mouthpiece brush**
- brass polishing cloth**
- optional: reed holder**



WHAT DO I NEED TO TAKE CARE OF MY INSTRUMENT?

Cleaning kits are available at Long and McQuade or St. John's Music in Winnipeg. You can also find them on Amazon but make sure everything is included (also a bit more expensive than the music store).
